OPENING

The gallery awards reception for artists and invited guests will be held Saturday, February 27, 7 to 8 p.m. in the Schorr Gallery on the third floor of West Jordan City Hall located at 8000 S. Redwood Road.

ELIGIBILITY

This special exhibit is open to all living Salt Lake County artists. Age restriction: 18 and over. Limit: three entries per artist. All art must be original, framed with eyelet hangers, and ready to hang. Two-dimensional media (including, painting, drawing, pastels, collage, printmaking, and textiles. No photography).

SALES

A 25% commission will be retained by West Jordan Arts Council on all sales. Funds raised will go towards promotion of the Arts in West Jordan. Work will be sold at the price listed on the entry form. All work must have a sale price that includes the 25% commission or if not for sale an insurance value must be indicated.

FEE

A non-refundable fee of \$8 for each entry or \$21 for three (limit of three) made payable to the City of West Jordan, must accompany artwork.

RECEIVING

Entries will be accepted at the Schorr Gallery located at West Jordan City Hall, third floor, on Monday, February 22 and Tuesday, February 23 from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. An entry form should be completed and attached to each work submitted.

RETURNING

All entries juried into the exhibition must be picked up from the Schorr Gallery Monday, April 12 and Tuesday, April 13 from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. West Jordan Arts Council or the City of West Jordan will not be responsible for any works not picked up by the applicable return dates unless prior approval has been granted.

LIABILITY

The City of West Jordan will insure all entries through the exhibition for the amount listed as sales price (insurance price if "NFS"), subject to an appraisal by a professional appraiser or arts consultant. Only those works accepted for the exhibition will be insured.
