**Veterans Day Parade and Tribute Nov. 11**

(West Jordan, UT) – The City of West Jordan is partnering with the United Veterans Council to present a Veterans Day Parade, program and fundraising luncheon Nov. 11. A flyover by the National Guard will start the parade at 11 a.m. The parade runs north up Redwood Rd. starting at City Hall (8000 S. Redwood) and turns west on 7800 South, then turns south at 1985 West and winds through Veterans Memorial Park finishing at the Military Services Monument.

A traditional military ceremony with color guard will then be held featuring remarks from Congressman Jason Chaffetz and parade Grand Marshal retired Command Master Sgt. Jerry Chidester. Jen Hajj and Sgt. Jessica Robson will be performing the “The Star-Spangled Banner” and “God Bless America” respectively.

After the program, a fundraising chili luncheon benefiting the VFW’s Military Assistance Program will be served.

The West Jordan Arts Council will also be presenting a USO-style show at the Sugar Factory Playhouse, 8201 S. 2200 West, at 8 p.m. featuring a magician, comedian and West Jordan theater members performing some of their favorite selections from past productions. The emcee will be in “Bob Hope” mode to add to the fun.
